

Doctor Marie Fonseca, Thank You

Doctor Marie Fonseca must have had very mixed feelings on Friday 28 April 2017. It was her last day at work in her Medical Practice which she had developed from the very beginning back in 11 September 1975.

Marie completed her internship of one year and worked in a Paediatric Hospital for another year in St Lanka, before arriving in New Plymouth (along with husband Lino) in late 1973. Marie worked at Tararua Base and Hawera Hospitals as a House Officer and later in the Accident and Emergency Department of Base hospital. The Fonseca family then moved to Inglewood following a sudden vacancy created by Dr Renne who had taken up the position in Auckland joining the other solo practitioner Dr Bob Watson on his own.

Then the Inglewood Mayor Darryl Crowe was instrumental in Marie taking up this position and he was assisted by the Town Clerk Arie Smith.

Mayor Darryl, his wife Daphne and Dr Watson welcomed the Fonseca family with open arms and helped them to settle down in the town. Marie and Lino's daughter Phyllis was 18 months old at the time and they were grateful to the lovely people who looked after her and the other two children, Niklas and Stratos, who were born later, while both parents worked full time, as well as Marie being on duty and on call after hours. Without them Marie says they could not have managed.

As a doctor, Marie says many things have changed since she started nearly 42 years ago in Inglewood and one important thing is that the pre-hospital care is much more advanced when a doctor attends to emergencies. The negative side is that the administrative and paper work, which now takes up a good deal of time and energy. As for her doctors rooms, the first were the old police station which was renovated to include a surgery at one end and accommodation in the main area. Later Doctor Marie moved to Ross Street and then in 1986 to the current rooms in the Inglewood District Health Centre in Brown Street.

Marie says she was very fortunate to have fantastic long serving staff and was grateful for their invaluable service and loyalty. She also thanks her past staff.

Dr Diane Jones and Doctor Stephen Franigan have worked together for a long time with Dr Marie Fonseca and Marie would not thank them, and staff and all others who work at the Medical Centre for their friendship and help. Marie said the sincerely wish that all her patients, past and present for getting their faith in her and allowing her to care for them. Over the last couple of weeks Marie has received numerous cards, flowers, and phone messages wishing her well. She is very touched to know you care and thank you.

Marie's replacement Dr Chris Morrison who started on 1 May is very keen to continue to serve you well in a very professional manner in the same friendly environment that you know.
